Ujjain (Mahakaleshwar Temple)



Regarded as one of the seven sacred cities for Hindus, Ujjain is an ancient city located on the banks of Shipra River in Madhya Pradesh. The city is also the venue for Kumbh Mela also known as the Simhastha Mela, held every 12 years.

The Mahakaleshwar Temple, one of the 12 Jyotirling shrines of Lord Shiva is in Ujjain. Lord Krishna received education along with Balaram and Sudama from Maharishi Sandipani here in Ujjain.

Distance from Indore : 55 Km.

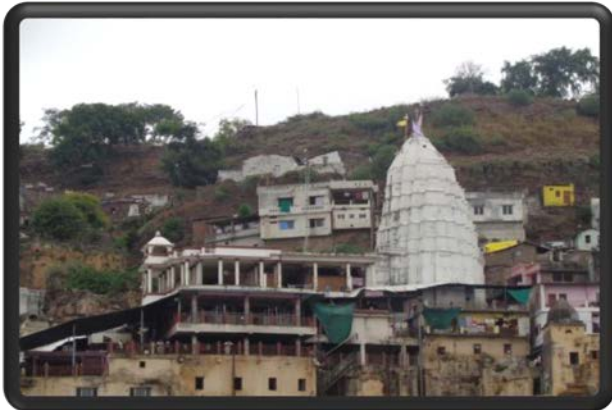
Omkareshwar

Omkareshwar is a Hindu temple dedicated to God Shiva. It is one of the 12 revered Jyotirlinga shrines of Shiva. It is on an island called Mandhata or Shivapuri in the Narmada river.

The shape of the island is said to be like the Hindu ॐ symbol. There are two temples here, one to Omkareshwar (whose name means "Lord of Omkaara or the Lord of the Om Sound") and one to Amareshwar (whose name means "Immortal lord" or "lord of the Immortals or Devas").

But as per the sloka on dwadash jyotirligam, Mamleshwar is the jyotirling, which is on other side of Narmada

Distance from Indore : 78 Km.

Mandavgad (Mandu)

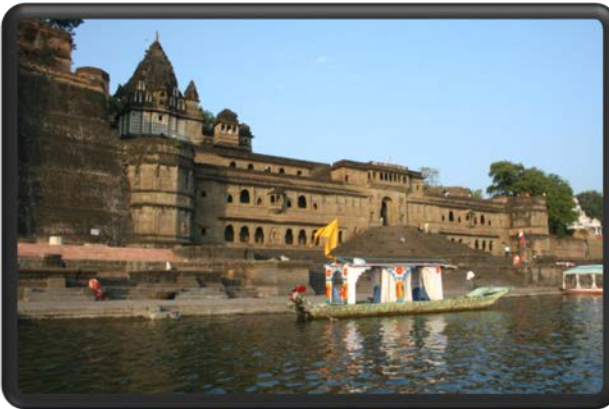


Mandu or Mandavgad was a pleasure resort; its lakes and palaces the site of splendid and extravagant festivities under Mughal rule. Situated in Dhar district of Malwa region in western Madhya Pradesh, the city was originally founded in 11th century by Parmar rulers who made it their fort capital.

Mandu has a number of wonderful palaces, baths, attractive canals and artistically crafted pavilions. Rock cut caves with enchanting paintings decorating the walls and ceilings are added attractions.

Distance from Indore : 95 Km.

Maheshwar



The temple town of Maheshwar is located in Khargone district of Madhya Pradesh. Situated on the banks of Narmada river, the town was once the capital of Holkar dynasty before it was shifted to Indore.

A prime attraction of the town is the Holkar Fort. Located on the banks of Narmada river, it was the residence of Rani Ahilyabai Holkar. The ghats of Maheshwar are another tourist attraction. As the town is located on the banks of holy Narmada river, the ghats represent the essences of religious Indian cities. It is the place where devotees do meditation.

Distance from Indore : 93 Km.
