During scrutiny, it has been observed that you have supplied false information to the institute. You have not disclosed that you are a Director / Stakeholder in a firm namely **M/S Fifteen Kopars Ind. Private Limited** engaged in Contractual Surveys (LAA). On the other hand, you are accepting survey jobs as an Independent Surveyor. You are very well aware that the Institute awards membership to act as an "Independent Surveyor." This appears to be a case of Conflict of Interest. If found true, this may lead to many complications as far as GST and Income Tax Departments are concerned. This will not only be a concern for you but a concern for the Institute and its image also.

It is further observed that you are administering a fictitious email address (unregistered with IIISLA) and communicated through the said address not only to our organization but to the high-profile officers of other organizations also. You attempted to disrupt the proceedings of the recent past AGM of IIISLA held at Hyderabad. The very same email address was used in a communication made to IRDAI by a group of Corporate Surveyors. Your social media postings, flaring of unconfirmed information's to members has also become a cause of concern for the management. Spreading rumors without any confirmation from HO, IIISLA, sharing official documents in bits and pieces has become a routine affair for you. These acts are creating a state of confusion within the circle. We are getting repeated calls from desperate members related to your unconfirmed and self-analyzed postings.

So in light of the above, the BOD has decided to initiate an enquiry into your present professional status and conduct within the organization. Pending enquiry, the Board has decided to suspend you from the primary "MEMBERSHIP" of the institute with immediate effect.
