Bus Service :

There is frequent AC & Non AC bus service to Digha from various locations in Kolkata, Howrah, Burdwan , Bolpur , Siliguri , Asansol . Kirnahar , Baharampur and many other parts of West Bengal.

Train Service :

There are multiple Express train services to Digha from Bhubaneshwar, Kharagpur, Howrah & Santragachi including one entirely AC from Howrah.

Area

Digha has mainly two beaches, one at Old Digha and the other at New Digha. Due to heavy tidal waves, big stones and boulders, sea bathing is mainly done in New Digha sea Beach which is a walking distance from the training venue. Very near to the venue are the Science City, Amaravati Park and a wonderful Aquarium. Participants can enjoy evening here.

Other tourist locations nearby are the century old Temple of Lord Shiva at Chandaneswar near Bengal and Orissa Border, Taal Sari, Sankarpur Beach, Mandormoni Beach (the only hard and drivable beach in Eastern India), Taajpur beach (sea & pine forest creates wonderful scenery) & Udaypur Beach. Sunrise on the Bay of Bengal at New Digha is a natural beauty.

Participants can enjoy the early morning at the sea beach and the evening at the other locations including marketing at old and New Digha. Both Old and New Digha are nearby and widely communicated. The programme has been designed leaving enough time to participants to enjoy the tourist destination. Participants eager to come with families may contact the organizers for help and accommodations.
